Putting safety first

Safety is a top priority for forklift owners and operators. In addition to protecting people, investing in workplace safety also makes good business sense as it enhances productivity and reduces losses from damaged goods.

Toyota is a recognised leader in delivering the latest safety technology, including its System of Active Stability (SAS), which actively stabilises trucks and loads.

Maximum mast control

The 7FBFEF range is equipped with the SAS active mast control, which protects both drivers and loads when lifting, lowering, and tilting the mast.

Depending on the load weight and the height at which it is carried:

- Active Mast Front Tilt Angle Control automatically limits the forward tilt angle. This helps to prevent overloaded trucks from tipping and prevents loads from slipping off the forks.
- Active Mast Rear Tilt Speed Control limits the backward tilting speed, helping to prevent loose loads from dropping onto the driver's cabin.

Secure loading and unloading

Toyota Auto Fork Levelling protects goods against damage and ensures faster pallet handling. Drivers can place the forks in a perfectly horizontal position by pushing a button, thus simplifying loading and unloading.

Easy braking

The Accel-Off braking system reduces the time required to stop the truck, giving operators more time to react before having to engage the brake. Progressive braking force is automatically applied as soon as the operator's foot is lifted from the accelerator, delivering a more natural driving experience.

Driving position

The Active Steering Synchronizer constantly re-aligns the steering wheel with the rear wheel to deliver a safer, more comfortable driving experience.

Control on ramps

To protect operators, machinery and goods, the 7FBFEF range offers enhanced control when driving up ramps. An active system helps to prevent trucks from freewheeling backwards when the operator's foot is removed from the accelerator. The truck maintains its position momentarily until the operator can apply the handbrake.

Only a seated driver can operate the truck

Toyota's Operator Presence Sensing (OPS) determines whether an operator is seated. The truck will not drive, lift or lower the mast unless the operator is seated, thus protecting the truck from misuse.





Driving for comfort

The Toyota 7FBEF range includes the Toyota Operator Total Care (OTC) package, which enhances operator comfort and leads to improved productivity. Every aspect of the truck's design addresses operator needs, from easy truck access to ergonomically designed controls and a comfortable driver's seat.



Easy entry and exit

The Toyota 7FBEF range accommodates drivers who must constantly get on and off their trucks. A low step-in height and a conveniently located handgrip provide easy access for any driver. The uncluttered floor area and adjustable steering column allow operators to quickly assume a comfortable driving position that fits their individual needs.

Take a seat

With Toyota's Operator Restraint System (ORS) seat, drivers can select and maintain a comfortable position all day, every day. This four-way adjustable seat features lumbar support and a retractable seatbelt. Its carefully designed side wings offer back support to drivers when they turn to look over their shoulders while driving in reverse.

Ergonomic controls for material handling

The optimal configuration for materials handling levers varies according to operator preference and the materials handling task. To cater to this, Toyota offers the choice of either mini-lever controls or multifunction levers. These systems are built into the ergonomic seat-mounted armrest and allow operators to quickly and comfortably execute various materials handling functions, including lifting/lowering, tilting and side shift.

Mini-lever control

Up to four mini-levers deliver fingertip control for all material handling functions. For ease of operation, the forward and reverse directional control is also built into the armrest.

Multifunction levers

Twin multifunctional electronic levers allow the operator to carry out multiple functions with each lever. For example, lift/lower and tilt forwards/backwards functions are combined in one lever. The forward and reverse directional control is also built into the armrest.

Turning power into productivity

AC²

The 7FBEF range features Toyota's AC² Power System, which optimises battery efficiency to keep trucks working longer and harder. In addition, Toyota's easy battery exchange solutions maximise uptime for round-the-clock operations.

Intelligent AC power

The AC² Power System combines compact yet powerful AC motors with a sophisticated AC controller to deliver optimal control and power output. Every Toyota AC counterbalanced truck features the Power Select function, which allows operators to control the AC² Power System to maximum effect.

Power Select offers a choice of three different power modes: Standard, Power and High Power. Standard mode is designed for operations with slower materials handling speeds. The use of somewhat slower speeds ensures maximum operating time from the battery. Power mode and the even faster High Power mode offer quicker handling speeds than Standard mode but reduce the overall operating time for the battery.

A dashboard control allows the operator to select the desired Power Select mode. It is also possible to fine-tune the power settings further, depending on the needs of the operator and application.

One pedal to accelerate and brake

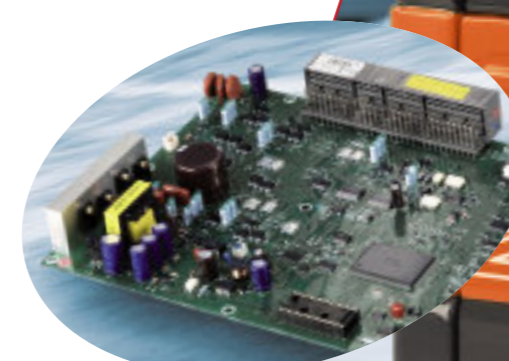
The Accel-Off braking system saves time and substantially improves productivity, particularly in confined and congested areas. Operators no longer need to constantly switch between accelerator and brake, as progressive braking force is automatically applied as soon as the operator's foot is lifted from the accelerator. There is a separate footbrake for emergency situations.

Regenerative braking

Toyota's Accel-Off braking system extends the operating time of the forklift by effectively converting the drive motor into a generator during braking and returning energy to the battery.

24-hour productivity

The Toyota 7FBEF range provides high performance and productivity over an entire shift. When trucks are required to work across multiple shifts, however, it may be necessary to exchange batteries. To this end, the 7FBEF offers two methods of battery exchange. The first method is Toyota's quick and easy horizontal battery exchange, where the battery is rolled off the truck sideways on rollers. The second method is the more traditional system of lifting the battery out of the truck's frame.

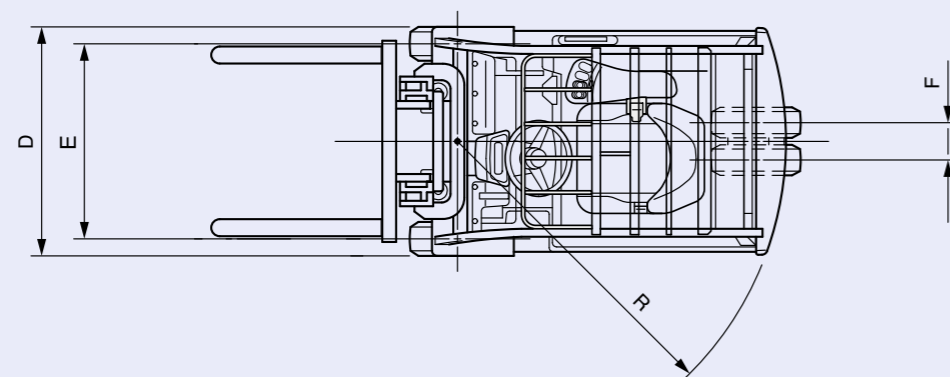
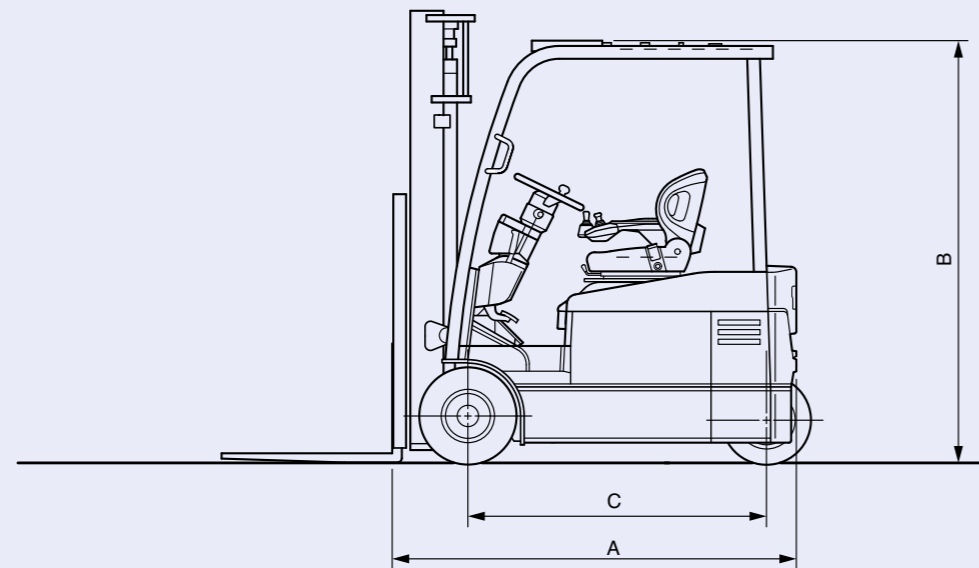
